

BinaxNOW OTC COVID-19 Self-Test Overview



- Each box contains two tests. Please read the instructions included in the box carefully.
- Failure to carefully follow instructions may result in a false negative.
- For a **positive** test please report your result to Summit County Public Health **immediately** using the following:

 - You should **isolate for 5 days** from your symptom onset or positive test date and at least 24 hours has passed since your last fever without use of fever-reducing medication and symptoms have improved.
 - Contact your work, school, friends, family, etc. and inform them of potential exposure.
- A **negative** test result means that proteins from the virus that causes COVID-19 were not found in your sample
 - It is possible for this test to give a negative result that is incorrect (false negative) in some people with COVID-19
 - If you are negative and having COVID-like symptoms, you should consider a molecular test (PCR, NAAT) and call your primary care physician for further instructions.
 - If you are negative, not having symptoms and were not exposed to someone with the virus, then no further follow-up is necessary.
 - If you were exposed to someone
 - and you are unvaccinated or your vaccinations are not up to date (over 6 months since primary series of Moderna or Pfizer, or 2 months since the primary series of Johnson and Johnson) stay at home for 5 days after last known exposure, continue to mask for 10 days after last exposure. A negative test on day 5 is recommended.
 - If vaccinations are up to date (less than 6 months since the primary series of Moderna or Pfizer, or 2 months since the primary series of Johnson and Johnson, or a booster dose has been received) and you are asymptomatic- wear a mask for at least 10 days after last exposure, a negative test on day 5 is recommended.
