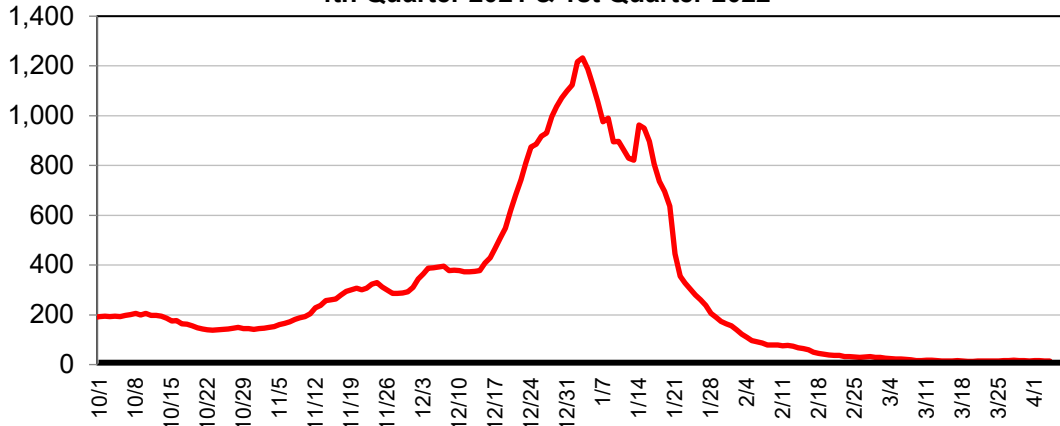




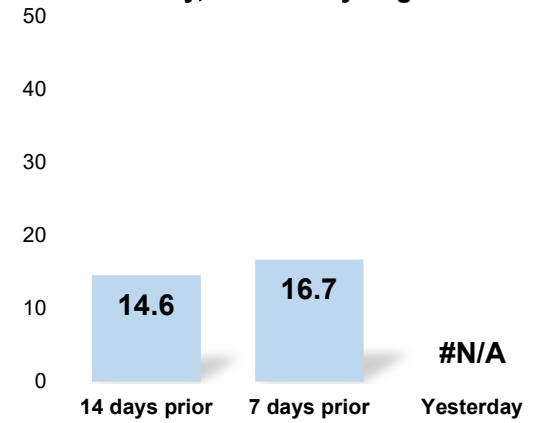

Sex of COVID-19 Cases

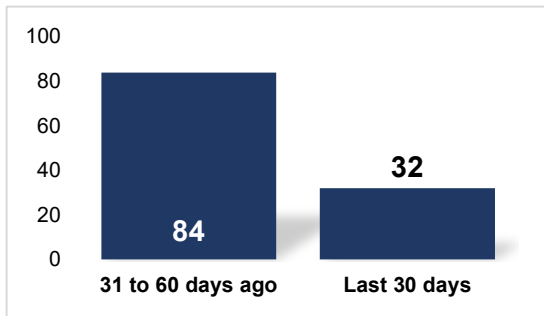

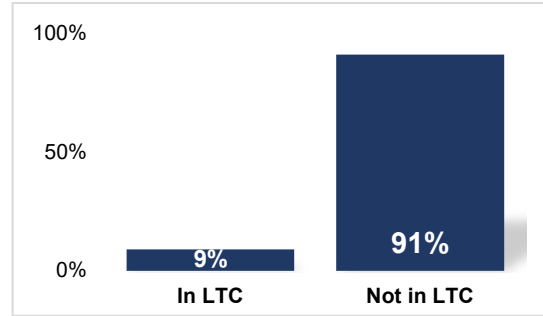

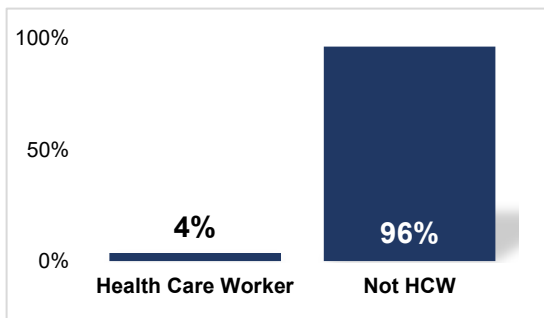
**Number of COVID-19 Hospitalizations**



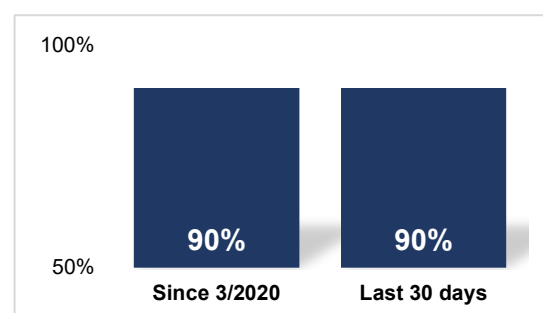
**% of COVID-19 Cases In Long-Term Care**



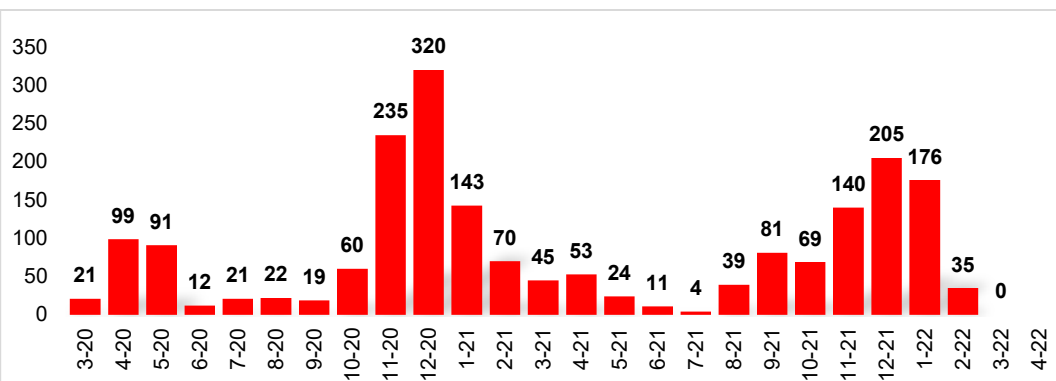
**% of Health Care Workers With COVID-19**
