CHAPTER 1850

Recreational Vehicle Parks, Recreation Camps and Combined Park-Camps

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 1850 was established by Resolution 156-02 adopted June 13, 2002. Recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, and combined park-camps were previously included in EHC Chapter 1624. Under authority of ORC 3733.03 through 3733.05, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces OAC 3701-25-51 through 3701-25-74 pertaining to recreational vehicle parks, recreation camps, and combined park-camps. This responsibility includes plan approval, licensing, inspecting, and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure compliance with requirements of the recreational vehicle park, recreation camp, and combined park-camp law and rules. The recreational vehicle park, recreation camp or combined park-camp law and rules are contained in a booklet published by the Ohio Department of Health, copies of which are available for distribution by the Summit County Board of Health.

There are no sections in Chapter 1850. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
