


# **Suicides In Summit County**





#### SUICIDE DEMOGRAPHICS, 2007-2022



<u>Age</u>: Suicides are rare before age 18, but happens more often as people approach middle age. People ages 45-54 make up one-fifth of all suicides in Summit County.

<u>Sex</u>: Males make up the vast majority of suicide deaths, 79% vs. 21% for females. This is also true nationally, and has been consistent in Summit County since at least 2007.





#### Race:

The suicide rate for Black individuals rose by 121% between 2013-2017 and 2018-2022. The White individual rate went down by 6% during that same period.

### **OTHER SUICIDE FACTS**

#### Educational Attainment:

Two-thirds of Summit County suicides are among those with a high school, GED, or lower educational level.

#### Marital Status:

Two-thirds of Summit County suicides are among those who were single and never married or divorced.

#### Causes of death:

Suicides are the 3rd leading cause of death among those ages 15-34.
