WHAT IS WIC?

WIC is a nutrition education program that provides nutritious foods that promote good health for pregnant women, women who just had a baby, breastfeeding moms and infants and children up to age 5.



WIC CAN HELP YOUR FAMILY WITH:

- WIC Nutrition Card (WNC) to shop at local grocery stores
- Nutrition education and support
- Breastfeeding promotion, support and education
- Referrals to Healthy Start, maternal, prenatal and pediatric care
- Manual or electric breast pumps for those who qualify
- Immunization screening and referral
- Voter registration

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR WIC?

- Are you pregnant, breastfeeding or have a baby less than six months old?
- Do you have an infant or child up to five years of age?
- Do you live in Ohio?
- Do you meet WIC income guidelines?
